

Instructions for Completing the NYSED Infection Control Exam

The New York State Education Department has issued an alert to all New York medical schools, mandating that every medical student taking an elective in **New York State Hospitals be certified in Infection Control.**

To meet this requirement, you must have a certificate indicating you have passed the Infection Control test. The procedure we recommend is:

1. Click-on or cut and paste this url into your internet browser:
<https://www.accesscontinuingeducation.com/ACE1002-cornell/course.htm>
2. Print out the Infection Control Workbook (50 pages) and the multiple choice test (18 questions)
3. After you have completed the test, input your answers into the Internet program and send it to the vendor. **You will be asked to pay a fee of \$30 at this time.**
4. If you **pass the test**, the vendor will send you a **“Certificate of Completion.”**
5. **Bring the “Certificate of Completion” to the Office of Global Health Education at the time of orientation.** Please note: No student will be allowed to start an elective without evidence that the Infection Control test has been successfully taken.
